Timber Volume in Indiana, 1986

ABSTRACT.—Presents statistics on Indiana's growing-stock and sawtimber volumes by county for 1986. Includes map showing growing-stock volume distribution by county.

KEY WORDS: Growing stock, sawtimber, species, counties.

Indiana's 4.3 million acres of timberland¹ supported 5.2 billion cubic feet of growing-stock volume² in 1986. During the 19 years (1967-1986) between inventories conducted by the USDA Forest Service, volume of growing stock on timberland increased by 43 percent (1.6 billion cubic feet), while acres of timberland increased by only 10 percent. The average growing-stock volume per acre increased from 938 cubic feet in 1967 to 1,215 cubic feet in 1986.

The State's growing stock is mostly in hardwood species. Softwoods as a group accounted for only 4 percent of the growing-stock volume in 1986. Although modest on a Statewide basis, softwood growing stock increased significantly between inventories:

Much of Indiana's timber volume is in two major species groups—oaks and hickories (table 1). Thirty percent of the State's growing-stock volume is in oak species. An additional 11 percent of the State's growing stock is in hickory species. Although the oak and hickory species comprise 41 percent of Indiana's growing-stock volume, they increased only modestly in volume during the 19 years between inventories. And, in the case of the species group identified as other white oaks, volume declined by 11 percent. It should be noted that many species in this group are, from a commercial standpoint, lower in quality and in value than the select white oaks. If all white oak species are grouped together, the "white oak group" experienced a 7.7 percent increase in volume. Other hardwood species increased greatly in growing-stock volume between inventories. The following tabulation compares hardwood growing-stock volume by species for both inventories:

In Indiana, the Doyle log rule has long been used by those involved in buying and selling logs. For national inventory purposes, the International $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch log rule is used. Therefore, to permit regional comparison and to allow for local usage of data, sawtimber volume by species group and county are presented in table 2 using the International $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch rule and in table 3 using the locally applied Doyle rule. The sawtimber volumes presented in the text are International $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch rule measurements.

The growing-stock volume of 5.2 million cubic feet also contains 19.2 billion board feet in sawtimber trees⁴. On a Statewide basis, total sawtimber volume increased by 54 percent between inventories. The average sawtimber volume per acre increased from 3,212 board feet in 1967 to 4,475 board feet in 1986. Sawtimber volume of some species groups increased greatly between inventories. As shown in the following tabulation, the sawtimber volumes for yellow-poplar, ash, and soft maple more than doubled between inventories:




Figure 1.—Forest inventory units, and growing-stock volume by counties, 1986.

Growing-stock volume is largely concentrated in the southern part of the State (fig. 1). The Knobs Unit in south-central Indiana contains 18 percent of the State's land area, but 45 percent of the State's growing-stock volume and 45 percent of the sawtimber volume. Perry County, in the Knobs Unit, has the most growing-stock and sawtimber volume of any county in the State (tables 2 and 3).

The south-central and southwestern parts of Indiana—the Knobs and Lower Wabash Units—contain two-thirds of the State's growing-stock volume. Although timber volume is concentrated in this area of the State, it has been increasing in much of the rest of Indiana. Between inventories, growing-stock volume in the Northern and Upland Flats Units, combined, increased by 63 percent (57 and 79 percent, respectively). At the same time, growing-stock volume in the Knobs and Lower Wabash Units, combined, increased by 34 percent (33 and 37 percent, respectively).

Statistics presented in this note are from a Statewide inventory conducted in 1985 and 1986 by the Forest Inventory and Analysis Project, North Central Forest Experiment Station, USDA Forest Service, in cooperation with the Indiana Department of Natural Resources. Funding provided by the Indiana State Legislature through the Forestry Division, Department of Natural Resources, increased the accuracy of the inventory.

Sampling error is estimated to be ± 1.57 percent for the total growing-stock volume in Indiana of 5.2 billion cubic feet. Sawtimber sampling error is estimated to be ± 1.86 percent for the State total of 19.2 billion board feet.

⁴Net volume of the saw log portion of live sawtimber trees (softwood 9 inches d.b.h. or larger and hardwood 11 inches and larger) from the stump to a point in the central stem at which utilization for sawn products is limited by large branches, forks, or other defects or by a top diameter outside bark of 7 inches for softwoods and 9 inches for hardwoods.
